



THE BIG QUESTION:

HOW DO I GET A COVID-19 VACCINE?

Register on the National Electronic Vaccination Database

In order to get a COVID-19 vaccine, everyone has to register on the National Department of Health's Electronic Vaccination Data System.



Dr M and her team at CareWorks are available to help you at every step of the process.

Once you have completed your CareWorks health assessment, Dr M and her team will let you know when it is your turn to register. You will not be allowed to register until it is your turn to do so.

How do I register?

- Online at vaccine.enroll.health.gov.za
- Using WhatsApp: send "register" to 0600 123 456
- Using the short code: *134*832#

At some stage you will be able to register in person at vaccination sites, but details have yet to be confirmed.

In order to register, you need your ID/passport number, medical aid details (if you are insured), cell number and home or work address.

You will receive an SMS confirming your registration.

How do I know when it's my turn?

You will receive an SMS with a unique code, an appointment date and vaccination site when it is your turn to be vaccinated

You must take your ID/passport, proof of medical aid and your unique SMS code to your appointment

You will receive counselling before you are vaccinated, and you will receive a second SMS when it is time to have your second dose of vaccine.

How can I prove I'm vaccinated?

After your second dose, you will be able to access an electronic vaccination certificate to prove you have been vaccinated.
