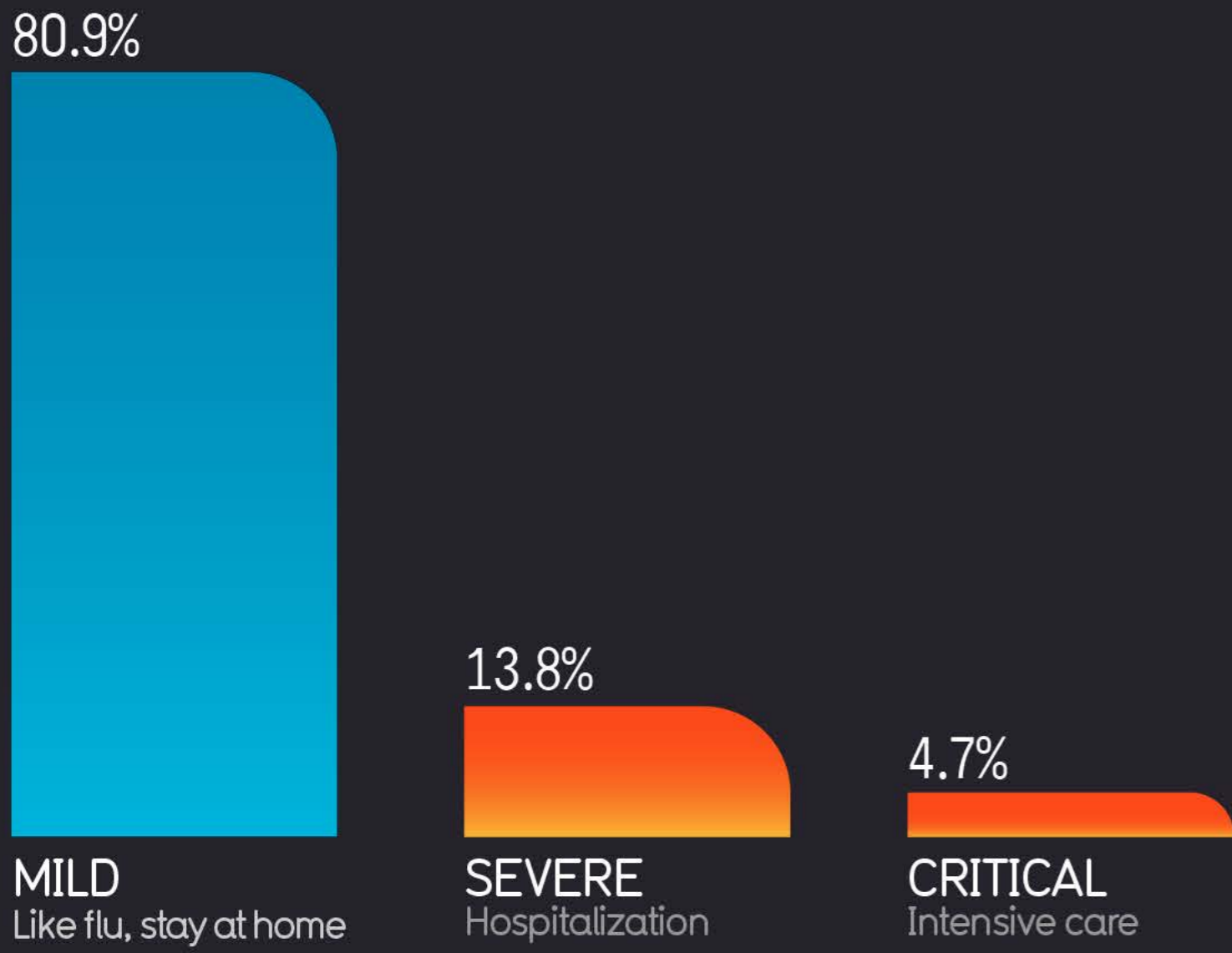

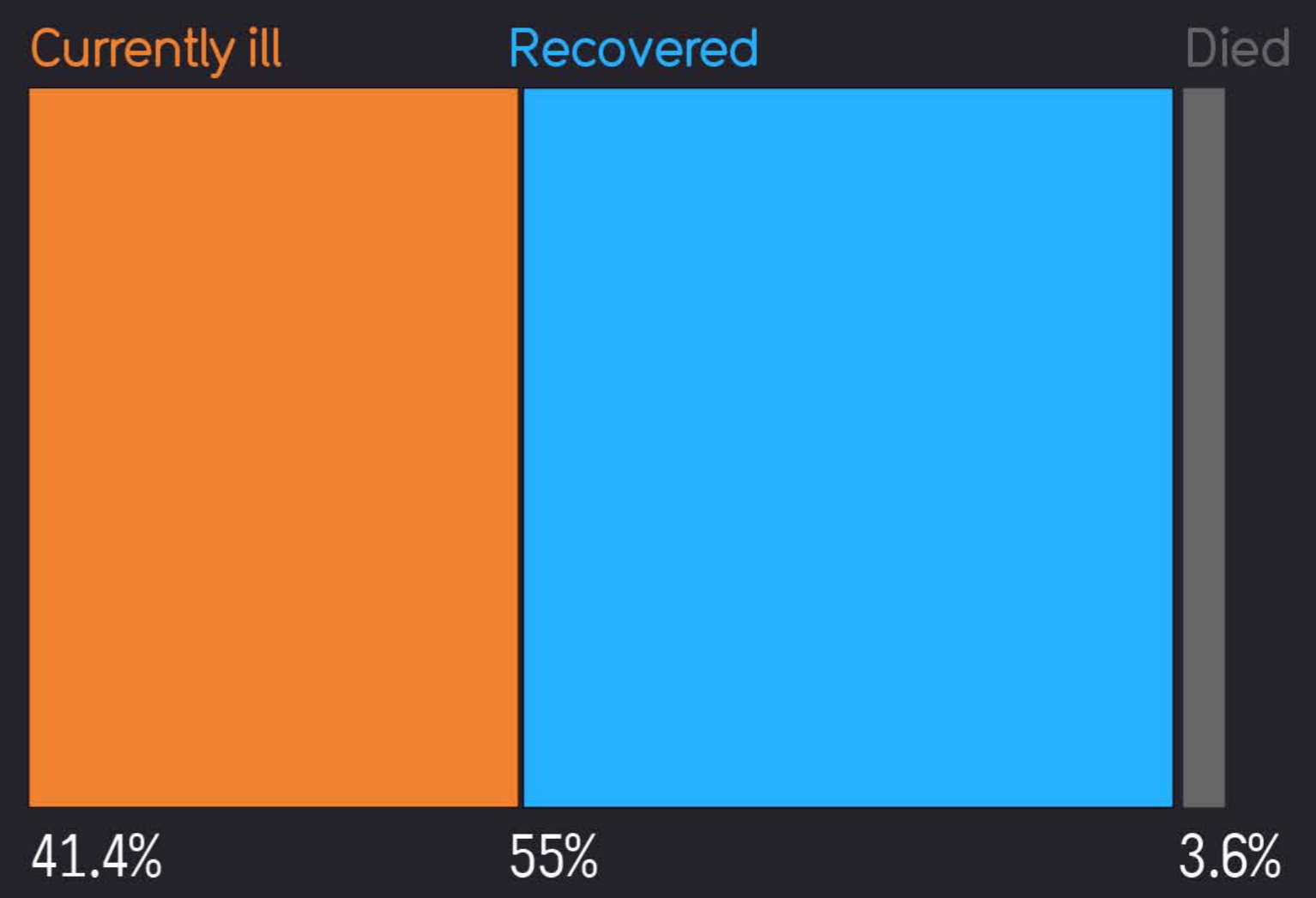
Seriousness of symptoms

## The Bulk of People Recover

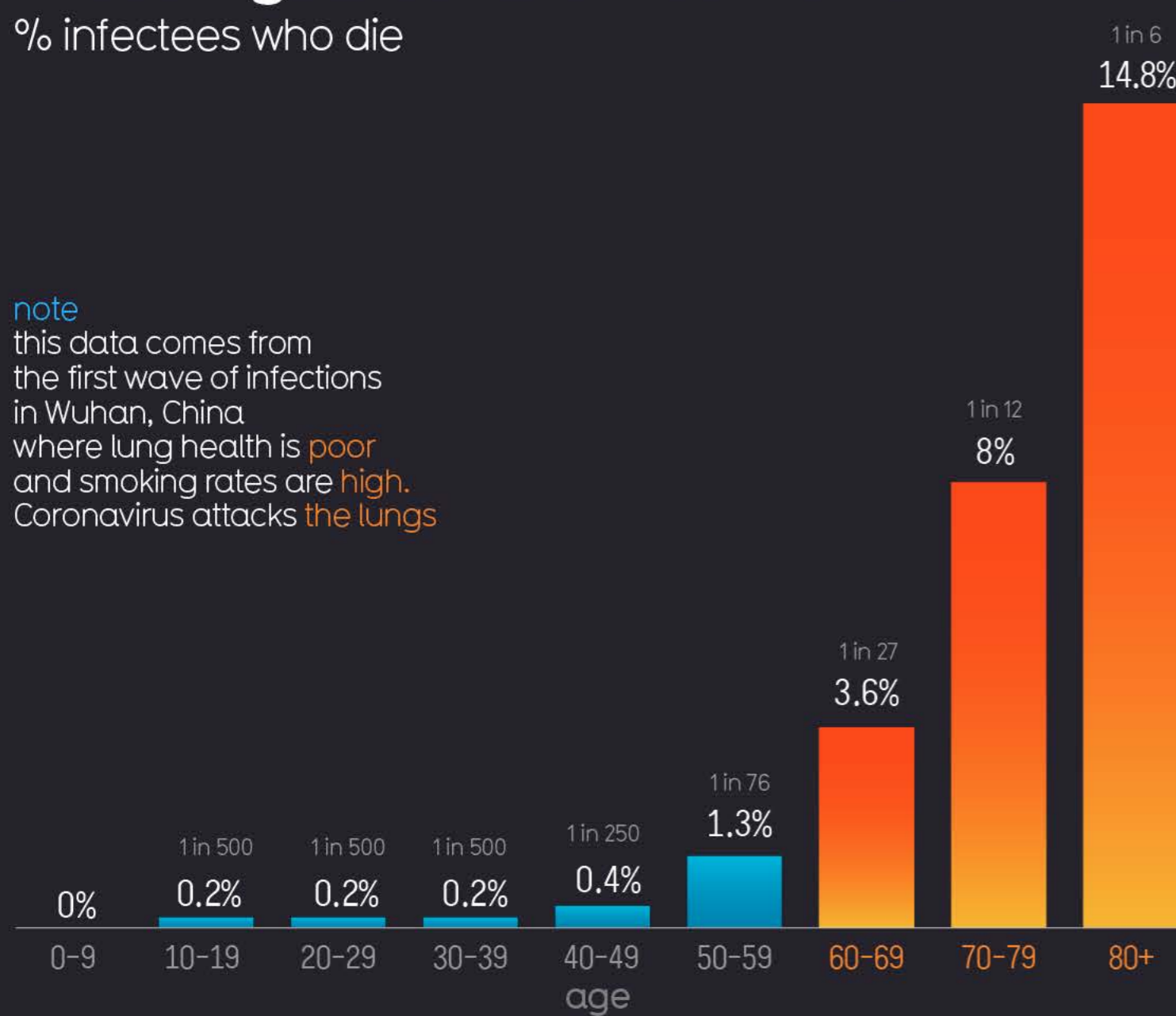
Of total worldwide confirmed cases...

% infectees who die

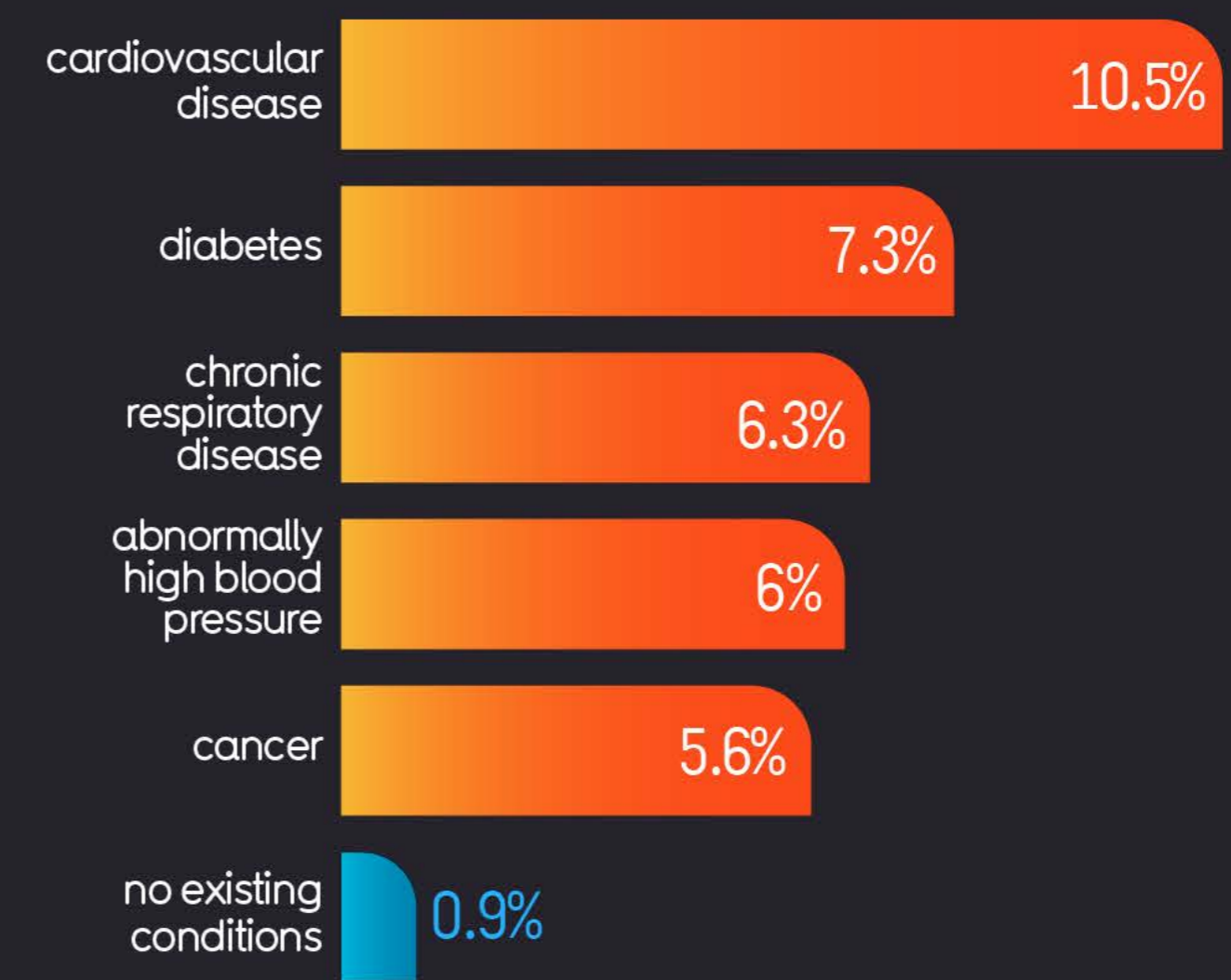

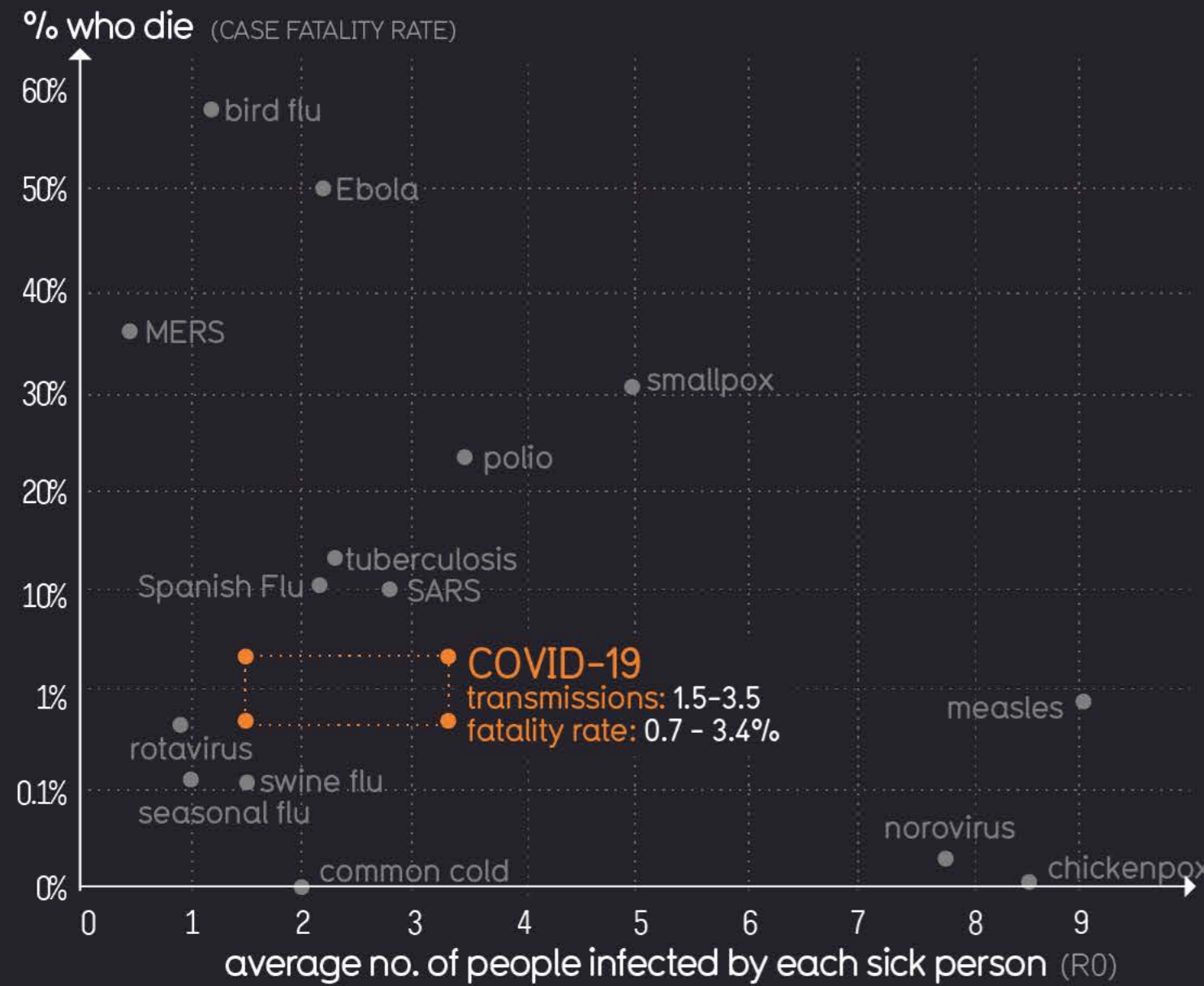
% with other serious ailments who die

## How Contagious & Deadly is It?

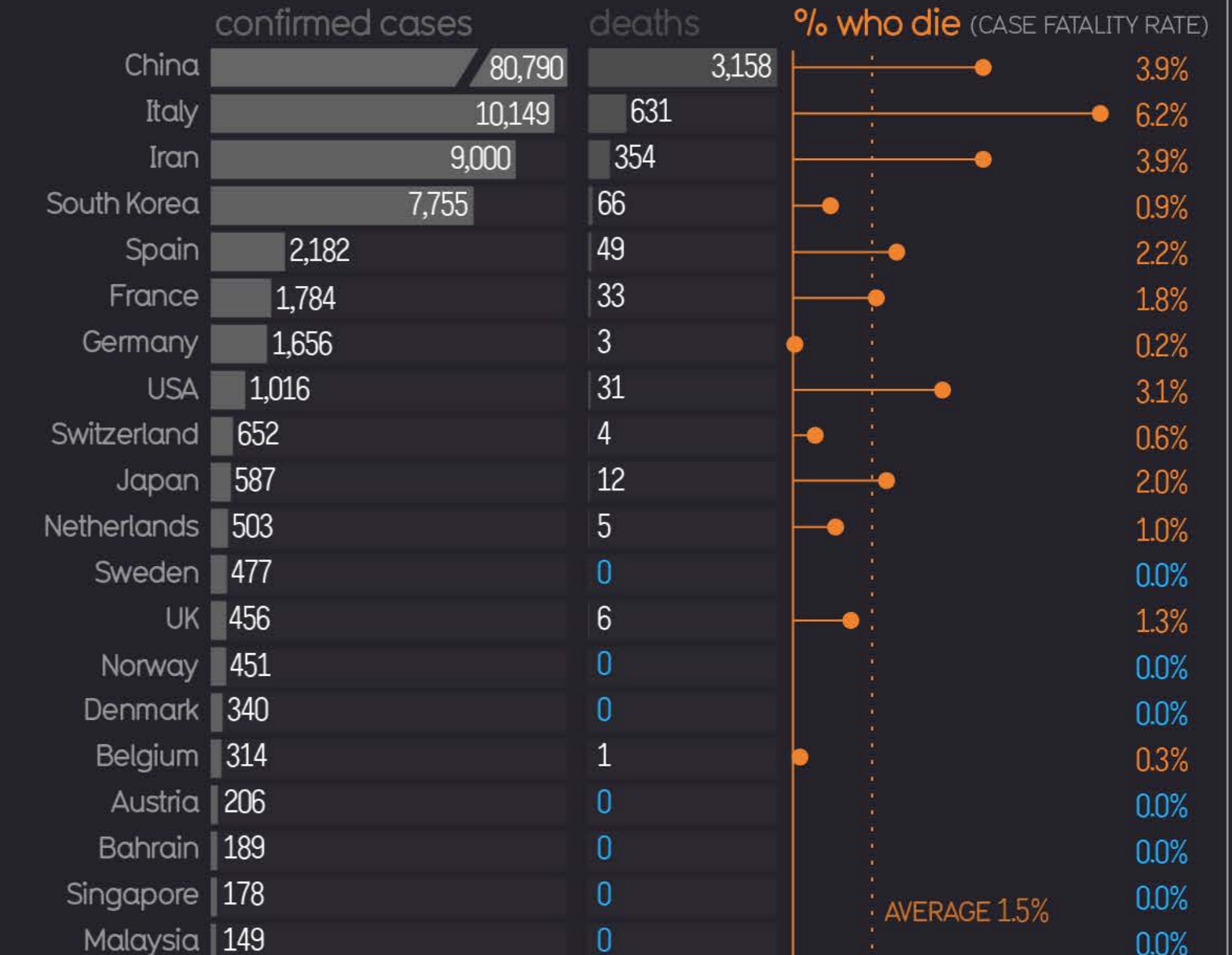
We don't fully know yet but it's in this range

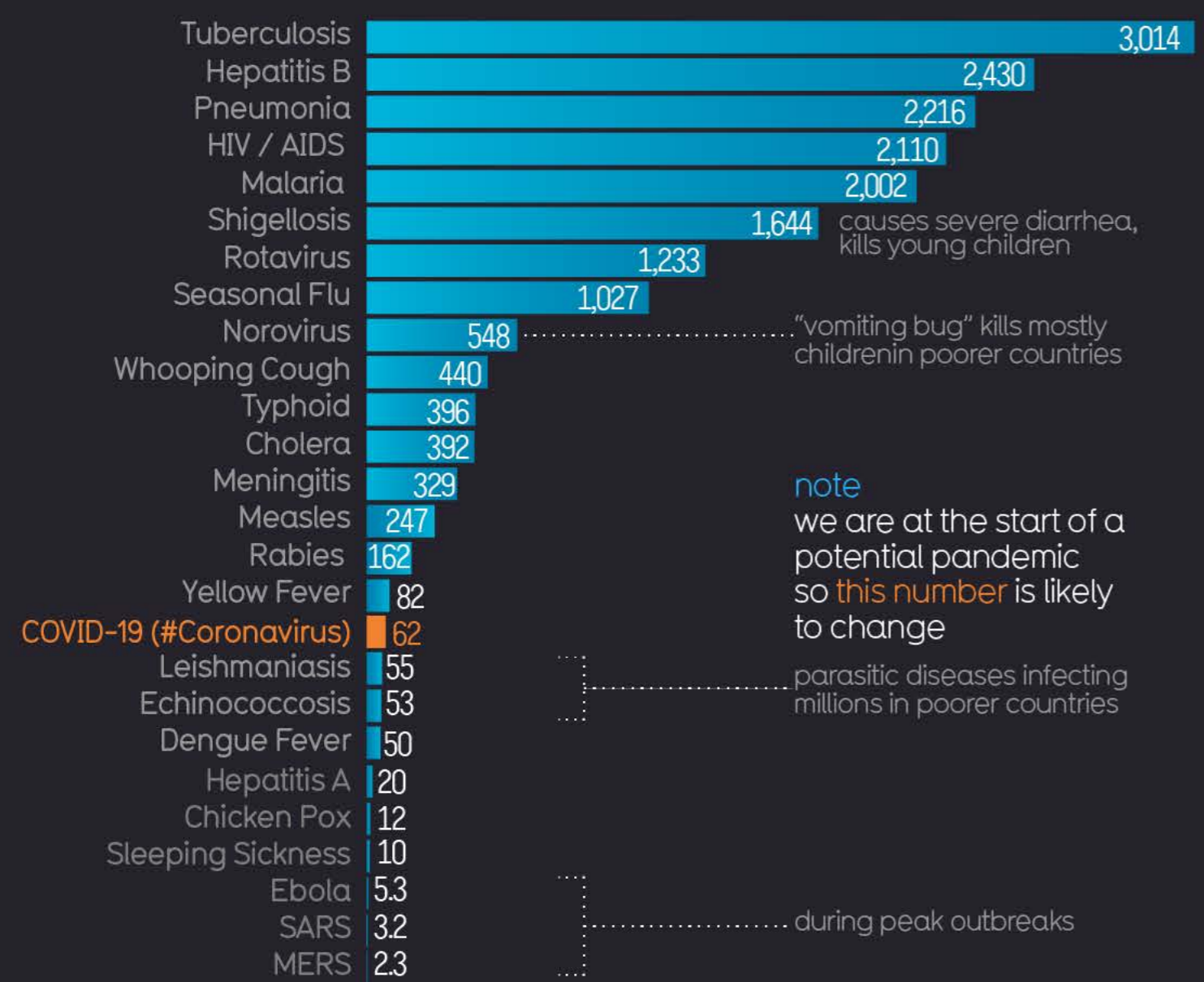
## The Case Fatality Rate Varies by Country

Quality of healthcare, average age of population - both factors



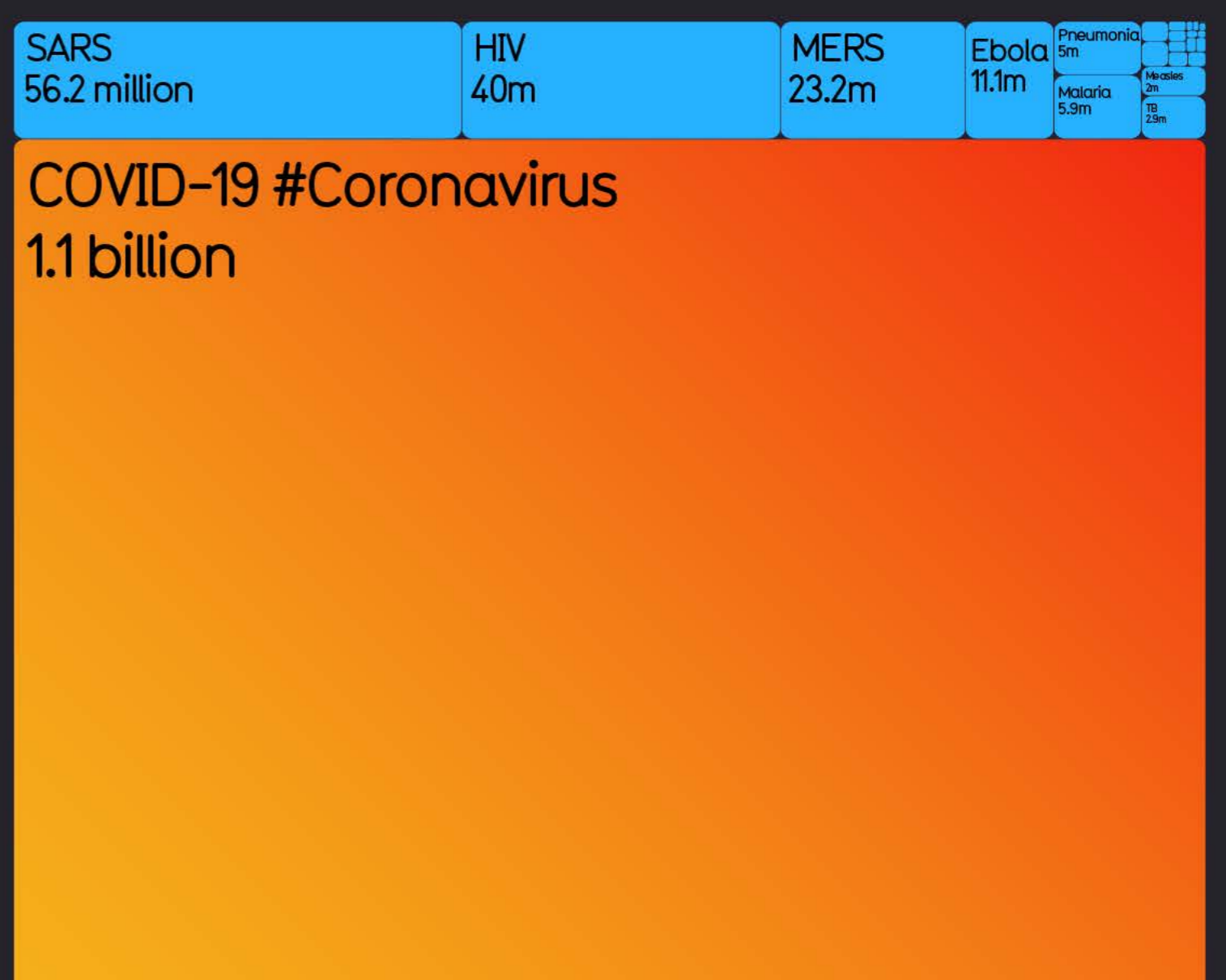
